


Peyton Storage Trundle Platform Bed



On this insert you will find a list of the hardware, platform bed and trundle parts as well as detailed assembly instructions. Assembly is quite simple and requires only a flat head screwdriver and a Phillips head screwdriver. The use of a power drill with Phillips head attachment is helpful but not necessary. Assembly will be most easily accomplished if you take the time to carefully sort the hardware and familiarize yourself with the function of each piece.







Then place the center plank in place, counter sunk hole side up, and secure the


planks into place with the 20mm wood screws.







Attach short end panels to the front and back panels with wooden dowels. (Diagram H)Use 35mm bolts to tighten the short end panels with the front and back panel (Diagram I).

Note: Do not tighten any of the bolts until all of them have been threaded at least part way.







(13) OPTIONAL COMPARTMENTALIZED STORAGE

To compartmentalize the storage drawer, simply add the wire retainers and the wooden dividers as you wish in order to achieve your desired size storage area (See Diagram \mathbf{K}).
