## Arthur Coffee and End Table Assembly Instructions



- 1) Be sure you have all of the parts listed below.
- 2) Place the top face down on a clean soft surface as shown in Figure 1.
- 3) Slide the legs into the slots indicated in Figure 1 making sure the legs are angled outwards.
- 4) Using two JC screws per leg and the "L" shaped hex key, tighten each leg into place but do not tighten completely.



- 1) Lower the bottom shelf down onto the ledge below the holes indicated in Figure 2 while making sure the holes in the legs line up with the holes in the bottom support of the bottom shelf.
- 2) Carefully rest the bottom shelf in place while you line up the holes and use the remaining 4 JC screws to attach the bottom shelf.(Note: You may have to use a small amount of sideways force on the legs in order to line up the holes correctly.)
- 3) Tighten these screws completely.
- 4) Go back and tighten the 8 JC screws on the underside of the tabletop. (Note: With the expansion and contraction of solid wood, you may notice the table will loosen up over time. Simply retighten these screws if and when necessary.)
