




1) Place the right side panel on the floor with the holes facing up, line up the front and back panels with the holes in the side panel and attach using (5) 45 mm bolts with the allen wrench provided. (See diagrams A and B)







2) Place the left side panel on the floor and flip the completed piece over onto the left panel. Line up the holes as in step one and attach with (5) 45 mm bolts. (See Diagrams C and D)


3) Now stand the unit up on it's feet and place the bottom section into the unit and screw in with (8) .5" wood screws provided. Make sure the side with the countersunk holes is facing up. (See Diagram E)







A) Now place the lid on the floor with the screw holes facing up. Lie the assembled unit on it's back on top of the lid with the hinges on the back section lined up with the holes in the lid. Attach the lid to the unit using (6) .5" wood screws provided. (See Diagram F)






6) Now locate the two paper roll holders and slide them onto the cam lock dowel pin. Make sure that the hole in the paper roll holder is facing the inside of the unit. Now slip the cam lock into the hole in the paper roll holder with the arrow pointing towards the back of the unit. Tighten the cam lock with a screwdriver clockwise until the holder has been pulled flush towards the back of the unit. (See Diagrams H and I)







7) Locate the safety spring hinge and screw into unit first with two .5" screws first then into the lid with two more of the .5" screws provided. (Note: you may need to lift the lid slightly to attach). (See Diagram J)




8) Place the chair back on its side then attach the chair seat by placing it on it's side and inserting the dowels on the seat into the holes in the seat back. Do the same with the seat front. (See Diagram K) Now insert two barrell nuts into the holes of the chair seat. Make sure that the holes in the barrell nuts line up with the bolt holes in the chair back and front pieces. (See Diagram L)






Now insert one 90MM bolt through the seat back into the barrell nut and tighten with the provided allen wrench, Then insert one 75MM bolt through the seat front into the barrell nut and tighten. (See Diagram M) Flip the chair over and repeat the same process.






10) To finish the assembly of the chair screw the 1" machine screw under the front of the chair and the 1" wood screw under the back of the chair. (See Daigram N)


